We would like more counties and agencies to participate in our meetings. Bonnie will set up 'Go To Meeting' Scheduling to involve more people. All participants must have 'Outlook'.

- County Boundary Project- It was determined we will move forward with this project. Jeff Servatius from the State Tax Commission was helpful in our discussion. He is checking with the state attorney on the issue of county boundaries moving with the change of the water boundary. He agreed that the Watershed layer is a good source for some boundary lines. We addressed the concern of making changes on a state level and the process of getting our findings adopted and 'gold stamped'. Eric stated we must first identify all issues and then resolve each problem. Each county is assigned stewardship over some of their county boundary lines and should get data to Eric as soon as possible.
- Mapping Federal and State Lands- Eric will contact Bureau of Reclamation for data. Craig stated that management of federal lands and ownership may be 2 different things.
- Eric contacted TeleAtlas, who then contacted Bruce Godfrey to collaborate on getting Idaho road data into TeleAtlas (google, garmin) database.
- Road Centerline Project- Eric said he will work on agreement points for road centerline file to get us started. There may be a grant available for counties who do not have road centerline completed. Gail Ewart working with Eddie Goldsmith on EMS statewide dispatch .
- Craig and Donna are now on the *Cadastral Reference Technical Working Group* of the Idaho Geographic Committee (IGC) rather than the *Parcel TWG*. Their efforts will be focused on enhanced GCDB.
- Sherry will contact Brett Hill to set up EIRGIS/CAI User Group.
