Topic: Creating Regional County Boundary Seamless Dataset

Meeting Objectives:

Assign stewardship for adjacent county boundaries in our region.

Determine best source to use when mapping county boundary.

- Attendees viewed a regional county boundary map that Eric created with data from Inside Idaho. Jefferson, Teton, Madison, and Fremont assigned stewardship for their common boundaries.
- Standards for county boundary .shp: Polylines with vertices at each quarter quarter State Plane- East Zone- NAD 83- Feet
- Counties will create and send data to Eric by January 9, 2009, and he will continue to build a regional county boundary dataset.
- Committee will meet again January 15 or 16.
- Sherry stated stewards should be responsible to continue to update when more accurate data becomes available.
- Craig stated we should revisit the boundary issues every 2 years.
- Craig will contact Jeff Servatis at State Tax Commission about STATE Boundaries.
- Sherry will contact Dawn concerning Jefferson south boundary/ Bonneville North boundary. GCDB data may not be best source for that boundary.
